Messanges Rouge is a local synonym of Cabernet Franc and Messanges is the little village where the “vins de sable” are produced—the red Cabernet Franc and the white Chenin Blanc. Fermented in concrete cuvees and bottled in May 2014, the 2013 Chinon Messanges Rouge is a fresh, fruit-driven, elegant and silky textured Cabernet Franc from the sandy 2.87-hectare Grand Clos de Briançon, located on the plane east to Chinon. It is a charming, rather light-bodied and slightly floral scented Chinon with blackberry and currant flavors; it has a nice gastronomic acidity and will benefit from a cooler serving temperature at 14°/15 C. Enjoy for lunch, in the afternoon or with sausages or goats cheese in the evening.
