The 2014 La Hormiga de Antídoto is Tempranillo from three small plots of old vines. This has a little more volume and feels a little more generous, a seductive wine, quite approachable, with noticeable high quality oak and a lactic touch, possibly a more commercial profile. The palate is medium to full-bodied with abundant, fine-grained, slightly dusty tannins, with stuffing and balance to develop in bottle, but the wine is delicious when young. Enjoy with powerful food. This is a better wine, but I enjoy more the style of the Antídoto from this same year. 6,000 bottles is what the one and something hectares of vines produce year after year until now. This wine will change in 2015 to increase the number of bottles.
