The 2017 Chinon La Rougerie is from two different plots on the same pure clay soils (planted with a sélection massale in 1952 with a density of 5,000 vines per hectare and in 2007 with 7,700 vines per hectare) and aged in Burgundian barrels for 18 months, the wine displays a dark red color and a deep, pure, intense and elegant meaty bouquet of dark and red berry aromas intertwined with toasty and floral notes. Smooth and silky on the firm palate, this is a full-bodied, elegant, refined and textural Chinon with a vibrantly fresh structure, serious tannins and a sustainable and fresh mineral finish. Bertrand considers La Rougerie as the "grand cru" of his range. Tasted in June 2021.
