The Domaine de Pallus 1969 Chinon, tasted with Bertrand Sourdais, displays a ruby-garnet color with an orange rim. Pure, fresh and mineral on the nose, with floral notes of red and dried fruits as well as raw meat, this is an intense, very elegant and silky-textured Chinon with the sweetness of an old wine but also with enormous freshness. The tannins are very fine, and this 1969 reveals the kind of concentration that late-ripening grapes can deliver after they fight for ripeness. In fact, 1969 was a very late vintage, with the flowering only after midsummer. Producer: Domaine de Pallus
