Like the "second wine" 2011 Pensées de Pallus, the 2011 Chinon Grand Vin de Pallus also needs its time in the glass to get rid of its woody flavors and to reveal its delicate and fresh red and dark berry aromas. This wine is full-bodied and silky textured, juicy and intense, but also very firm and barely ripe in its fruit and tannins. This is a fresh and vibrant Cabernet Franc from old vines (1954, respectively 1974) that develops a good though somewhat recalcitrant finish. The certain unripeness might be less disturbing with food, but is less easy to accept when you drink this Chinon solo. Producer: Domaine de Pallus
